Thy Kingdom Come:

The parish will once again be supporting this global prayer movement which begins on **Ascension Day (13 May)** and continues until the **Day of Pentecost (23 May)**. Thy Kingdom Come (TKC) invites Christians around the world to pray for more people to come to know Jesus. Since its commencement in 2016, Thy Kingdom Come has become an ecumenical movement with Christians from 172 countries praying 'Come Holy Spirit', so that friends and family, neighbours and colleagues might come to faith in Jesus Christ.

Parishioners can take part in 3 ways this year: (1) by using a prayer journal to reflect on designated readings for each day of TKC – the prayer journal will be emailed to everyone on the parish email list, and hard copies will be made available for those without email; (2) by following a Novena (9 days of prayer with a specific intention) on the parish Facebook page. Each day, there will be a psalm, some text and a picture. The opening and closing days of Ascension and Pentecost are like bookends to the nine days of prayer in between, setting the theme and drawing it to a close; (3) by attending a service of Prayer, Praise & Proclamation to be held in the church on the eve of Ascension Day on Wednesday 12 May at 7pm (which will also be live-streamed on the parish Facebook page).

We will also be encouraging families to take part in an interactive 'Digital Family Prayer Adventure Map' by downloading an app and following the activities (which include games for children) for each day.
